

## English B1 Round up

<b>Prerequisites</b>	<p>Module B1.2b</p> <p>This course is intended for students who have completed their learning path through the B1.2b course module but have not yet passed a B1 proficiency exam recognized by unibz. The course will include some preparation and practice for the B1 English exam offered by the Language Centre.</p>
<b>Textbook</b>	<p>Materials will be provided by the instructor.</p>
<b>Course content</b>	<p><b>Themes</b> Themes discussed during this course may include any themes appropriate for the B1 level, including family and friends, hobbies and free time, work, study, the environment, travel, and personal interests.</p> <p><b>Communication Goals</b> The communication skills practiced and developed during this course may include any skills relevant for the B1 level, including understanding and composing basic written or oral texts related to the aforementioned themes. Examples of written texts include emails, messages, and product reviews. Oral skills will include responding to questions and giving basic presentations which require describing, narrating, stating opinions and intentions, giving advice, and other skills expected of B1-level users of English.</p> <p><b>Grammar</b> Although focused on developing communicative competence at the B1 level, the course will review and consolidate all B1-level grammar, including modal verbs, tenses, etc.</p> <p><b>Vocabulary</b> The course aims to expand participants' lexical range and accuracy related to B1-appropriate themes.</p>
